YOUR RESIDENCE TELEPHONE NUMBER IS: 902-422-6011 + extension number.

LOCAL CALLS: Dial 9 + telephone number.

CALLING CARDS: After you dial 9, simply follow the instructions on the back of the calling card. Calling cards can be purchased at most convenience and grocery stores, the nearest being the University Kwik Way on Coburg Road, across from Howe Hall.

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM:

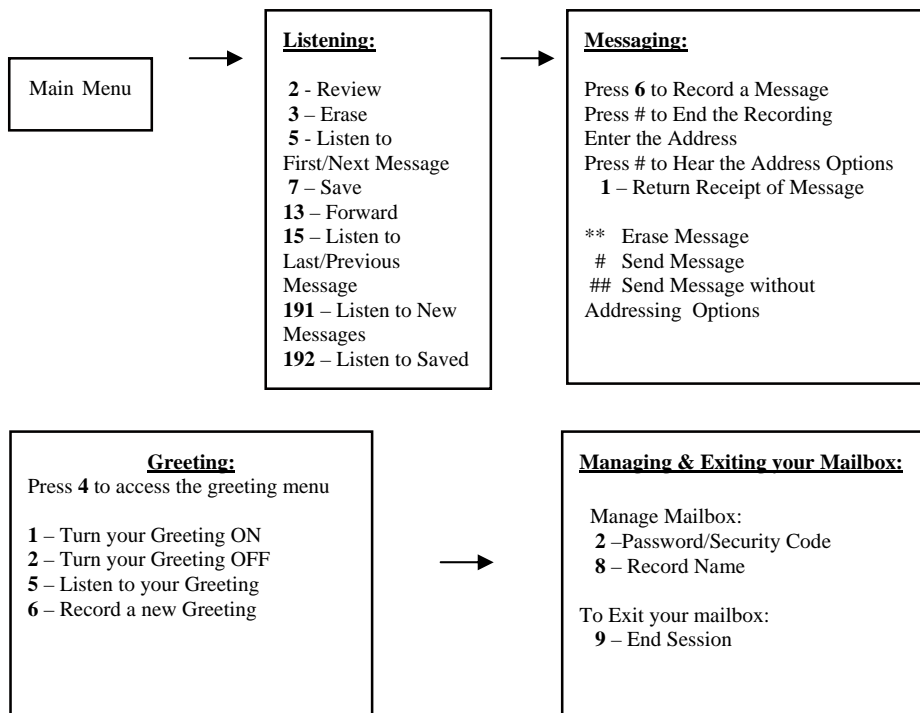
- You cannot use your phone line for Internet hookup.
- Internet dial up numbers are restricted. Do not connect a modem to the phone or jack
- You cannot contact an operator, or make a collect call through this system. Feel free to use any payphone on campus for this service. Payphones are located in Alex Hall and in the Arts & Administration Building.
- Calls received through the University's administration switchboard (902-422-1271) will not be redirected to residence.
- Telephone problems should be reported to Alexandra Hall Front Desk Reception ext: 132.

ACCESSING YOUR VOICE MAIL SYSTEM: From your own phone or another residence phone:

Voice Mail Setup: Press *(star key) 604, then * (star key) 701.

Voice Mail Instructions:

- Press 770.
- Press the # key.
- Enter your extension number.
- Enter password (first time only: # is 1111). You are now at the Main Menu.
